Dear Parishioners,

The General Data Protection Regulation

This letter is to advise you about Burrington Parish Council's compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018.

The Parish Council holds very little information that could be called '*personal data*'. We only have names and addresses and/or email addresses of people who have contacted the Parish Council for various purposes: in correspondence with the Parish Council; to receive notification of Parish Council meetings and agendas; for other meetings or events; relating to use of the burial ground; or in response to the survey or other action on broadband services. We also have a copy of the register of electors which is publicly available and is administered by North Somerset Council.

Contact data are held solely for the purposes for which they were provided by parishioners, and for only as long as required for those purposes. They will not be disclosed to any third party without consent.
